What we do

The Polarization clinical team is located at CLSC de Parc-Extension. We have a mandate from the Ministry of Health and Social Services (MSSS) to offer services throughout the province of Quebec in collaboration with our regional partners. The team includes social workers, psychologists, psychiatrists and child psychiatrists who are experts on social polarization issues.



Our services are adapted to meet individual needs and are free of charge, voluntary, and strictly confidential.

Services are provided in our offices at CLSC de Parc-Extension or in a more convenient location near you.

Reasons to consult us



You are concerned about questions in relation to social polarization and radicalization in all its forms (far left, far right, religious, other).

Some people consider your ideas or actions to be radical, which may make you feel uncomfortable or distressed.

You have been the victim of discrimination or of a hate crime or you fear it could happen to you.

You are worried that perhaps a family member or a friend is becoming radicalized and you would like to talk about it and see how the person could be helped.

You are worried about your family or your community being affected by social polarization.

Our services

We can provide you with strictly confidential advice, support, and accompaniment in all of these situations.

If you are not sure our services are suited to your needs, you can contact us to discuss it. We may then be able to refer you to other resources, if necessary.



We offer the following services to adults, teens and children:

- Psychological and psychiatric assessment;
- Psychosocial support and followup for individuals and families
- Psychotherapy;
- Assistance with school or employment reintegration.
