

Annual bursaries competition of of the SHERPA University Institute 2020-2021

SHERPA provides bursaries to graduate level students registered in universities across Québec.

Admissibility Criteria:

- Student is supervised/co-supervised by a SHERPA Researcher (regular member)
- The research project falls within one of the <u>IU SHERPA's research program</u> areas
- At the time of submitting the application, student must have at least one year to complete their program or to submit their thesis

Applications will be evaluated by a committee of researchers based on the following criteria:

- The relevance of the project in relation to the research program of SHERPA
- The scientific quality of the project (relevance of the issue, clarity of the objectives and methodology, etc.)
- The feasibility of the proposed project (based on the schedule, available sources of funding, etc.).
- The possible impacts on practice (non-mandatory but prioritized criterion).

To submit a project

- ✓ Complete the <u>online form</u> before November 13th, 2020 (16h).
- ✓ Ask your supervisor to confirm by email that he/she have reviewed your application and support its deposit. The email must be sent directly by the supervisor to <u>sherpa.dlm@ssss.gouv.qc.ca</u>. Application will not be evaluated without this email.
