Cultural adaptation project of a perinatal program for migrant women who have experienced trauma

The SHERPA University Institute of the CIUSSS du Centre-Ouest-de-l'Île-de-Montréal is an infrastructure financed by the Fonds de recherche du Québec Société et Culture (FRQSC) and by the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (MSSS). The research, evaluation and knowledge mobilization activities carried out have as their goal the advancement of knowledge and the development of best practices in front-line intervention in a multi-ethnic context.

THE PROJECT

As part of the postdoctoral fellowship, the intern will work with three IU SHERPA researchers (Naïma Bentayeb, IU SHERPA Institutional Researcher; Christine Gervais, Department of Nursing, UQO; and Mónica Ruiz-Casares, School of Child & Youth Care, Toronto Metropolitan University). The successful candidate will be specifically responsible for the development and implementation of a cultural adaptation project for the STEP program, which aims to support pregnant women who have experienced trauma. We are looking for someone with a strong interest in perinatal practices and issues in the context of migration.

AMOUNT AND DURATION

The amount of the postdoctoral fellowship is \$55,000 CAD per year for two years and eight months (32 months).

REQUIREMENTS

- PhD (obtained within the last 5 years) in a discipline related to intervention (social work, nursing, psychology, etc.). Candidates who are about to defend their thesis will be considered;
- Admission to postdoctoral studies at one of the supervisors' home universities;
- Excellent writing and oral communication skills in English and French.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience in project management and literature reviews;
- Strong aptitude for consultation processes with expert groups;
- Experience in working with immigrant populations;
- Organizational skills, autonomy and thoroughness;
- Knowledge of the Delphi method (an asset);
- Demonstrated interest in practices and issues related to perinatal care and intercultural intervention.

THE CANDIDATE WILL HAVE TO PROVIDE:

- A one-page cover letter demonstrating the applicant's motivation to do a postdoctoral fellowship at IU SHERPA in the context of the proposed project;
- Two letters of recommendation from researchers who have personal knowledge of the applicant's research;
- A curriculum vitae including scholarships, awards, publications, communications, other experiences reflecting scientific productivity, professional experience and full contact information;
- A copy of the doctoral degree or, if not available, a letter attesting to the submission of the thesis.
