SHERPA UNIVERSITY INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST 2023-2024

SHERPA University Institute scholarships are intended for students enrolled in a second or third cycle university program and supervised or co-supervised by <u>a regular UI SHERPA researcher</u>. Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$5,000.

Eligibility Criteria

Applications will be considered only if they meet all of the following eligibility criteria:

- Be enrolled in a 2nd or 3rd cycle program at a Quebec university;
- Be supervised or co-supervised by a regular SHERPA researcher;
- Carry out a project in line with one of <u>UI SHERPA's research programs and its areas of</u>
- expertise;
- Not have been awarded an UI SHERPA grant for the current project.

Evaluation of applications

Applications will be evaluated by a committee of researchers according to the following criteria:

- Relevance of the project to SHERPA's research program;
- The scientific quality of the project (relevance of the problematic, clarity of objectives and methodology, etc.);
- The committee's assessment of the feasibility of the proposed project (based on the schedule, the available sources of funding, etc.);
- Potential benefits for the practice (not a mandatory criterion, but one that is given priority);

Submitting an application

- ✓ Complete the <u>online application form.</u>
- ✓ Ask your director to:
 - 1. Read your application.
 - 2. <u>Send us an e-mail</u> confirming that he or she supports your application. Please note that your application will not be evaluated without the support of your director before the submission deadline.
- ✓ Submit your application before November 17, 2023 at 4pm.
