UI SHERPA Members Research Fund Competition SHERPA University Institute CIUSSS West-Central Montreal

The SHERPA University Institute (UI SHERPA) research support competition is intended for regular research members of the Institute (both academics and practitioners).

For the 2024-2025 competition, UI SHERPA will offer funding of \$8,000 per project. Funds will be awarded in January 2025 and must be used by March 31, 2026.

The funding aims to support the completion of targeted projects that have concrete and short-term outcomes, such as: preparing a funding application, conducting a literature review, drafting a policy brief, developing an intervention support tool, validating data collection tools, a pilot project, secondary data analysis, an evaluation of a practice, etc.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible, applications must meet all the following conditions:

- Align with UI SHERPA's research focus areas (research axes, fields of expertise, etc.): https://sherpa-recherche.com/en/;
- Involve at least two regular academic research members of UI SHERPA;
- Lead to the production of a tangible deliverable that will be shared with IU SHERPA by March 31, 2026 (e.g., research report, article, review, etc.) or for which IU SHERPA will be associated as a partner (logo, acknowledgment, collaboration, etc.).

EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Applications will be evaluated by a committee of researchers based on the following criteria:

- The relevance of the project in relation to UI SHERPA's research program and areas of expertise: https://sherpa-recherche.com/en/;
- The scientific quality of the project;
- The feasibility of the proposed project (based on the timeline, available funding sources, submission of the final deliverable to IU SHERPA before March 2026, etc.);
- The potential impact on practice.

Please note that only one application per researcher will be evaluated, whether as a principal investigator or co-investigator.

In the case of a tie, the evaluation committee will give priority to the project of an early-career researcher.
